

Data is your team's EFFORT.

How your team *thinks and feels* about data is one of the most important factors in any HS/EHS program.





Data is your team's EFFORT.

- The data you collect and store (Education, FCE, Health, ERSEA, etc) is a reflection of their professionalism
- This is personal and sensitive
- Related to their education and "self-view"
 - "I'm a data person". "I am NOT a data person".





Data Transparency

Every single one of your team members can explain, in their own words, exactly what is being collected and why.

AND

They can demonstrate how they use that data in practice
