
Child Development Associate Course



FIELDWORK:

- All ECE courses have a field work experience component
- Fieldwork must be in an approved setting, defined as working with children from birth to age 5 in an inclusive general education setting
- Recommended settings are Early Head Start and Head Start



Tuition Structure:

- There are <u>five</u> certificates and each takes <u>eight</u> months to complete. 40 month total length for the program.
- \$880 per course (or \$7,040 per certificate) with a total estimated cost: \$35,200
- If a student qualifies for a 100% Pell Grant, each certificate is \$0 out of pocket.


